

- 10 Presentation of awards also for the Principals and Teachers in schools who implemented this Programme. Teachers and Principals will be trained by YESL.
- 11 Opportunity for YESL students completing the Higher Level Company Program to appear and obtain Certificates in the Internationally recognized Young Enterprise Examination, conducted by Cambridge University of United Kingdom.
